1	<p>Census of Population and Housing, 1970: Urban Tract Atlas Boundary Files</p> <p>The Urban Tract Atlas Boundary files were prepared by the Lawrence Berkeley Laboratories under contract from the Bureau of the Census and the Manpower Administration. The files contain latitude-longitude (decimal degrees) descriptions of boundaries of 1970 Standard Metropolitan Statistical Area's census tracts. The boundary data are presented in the form of polygons with common boundaries repeated for each polygon. Islands with holes internal to polygons are treated as separate polygons. 2 **ZIP Code/Tract Cross-Reference File**

The ZIP Code/Tract Cross-Reference file is a geographic reference file comprised of a listing of State, county, place, ZIP/Census tract combinations. Each record contains place, county, and state names. The file contains reference data for all urbanized portions of the 230 SMSA's that existed at the time of the 1970 Census, with the inclusion of the Appleton-Oshkosh, Wisconsin SMSA. No data for Puerto Rico SMSA is included. There is one file with approximately 59,000 records.
