1.	<p>1604-05 <u>Project Computation files.</u> Sheets listing computed settings for the projection machine for plotting of the grid system (latitude and longitude) or map manuscript material.</p> <p align="center">Retention: Destroy immediately.</p> <p>The records described in this series were used for plotting the projections of map manuscript material on a projection ruling machine which was discontinued about 20 years ago.</p> <p>The original reference to "Projection Computations" is found as Item 9 of National Archives Job No. II-NNA-1300. Their disposition here is "Retain." But, with the obsolescence of the system, there is no need to retain the manual projection plotting data. With computerized plotting of map projections, the projections can be regenerated as required. This plotting program itself would be described in ADP records, and need not be mentioned under nautical charts functional files.</p>		WITHDRAWN
