Photographs are arranged in 13 subseries corresponding to the atmospheric tests conducted during the period. Coverage for each test consists of pre-test site photos, photos of the detonation, and post test site photography. Series consist of ca. 970 jacketed captioned negatives mostly 4x5 with a few 5x5, 8x10, and 9x9; and captioned contact prints. Approximately 50% of the photos are color. All photos are unclassified and cleared for public release.
