The inputs are processed manually by CMPP personnel. The meat cutting and CMPP systems allow users to print cutting test and inventory results with suggested retail prices. The meat cutting system and CMPP system outputs include:

- o Various Reports to include Store Shipping, Price Changes, Cost of Markup
- o Tests to include meat cutting and meat processing test
- o General Ledger to include:
 - o Receipts
 - o Transfers in/out
 - o Vendor Credit Memo
 - o Vet Samples
 - o Cash Sales
- o Inventories
- o Store Information
