Rule 5.3. Added for Air Force Law Enforcement Terminal System (AFLETS) computer entries, per your letter request of 25 Mar 1982. The security police activity that requested an entry be placed in the NCIC computer via the AFLETS terminal notifies the AFLETS terminal manager when the entry is no longer valid. As a cross check, the terminal manager checks monthly to see if computer entries are still valid. When a computer entry is no longer valid, the terminal manager cancels it immediately from the NCIC computer.
