on tools/equipment not found, destroy 6 years after annual cutoff; on tools/equipment recovered, destroy when no longer needed.

The nature of tools/equipment as a source of Foreign Object Damage is such that the damage may occur long after the Programmed Depot Maintenance Cycle, which generated the Foreign Object. AFLC conducted a study from which it was determined that 6 years is the minimum time required on tools/equipment not found to ensure that respective weapon system platforms are cycled through the Programmed Depot Maintenance at least once before applicable records are disposed of.
