The Soldier Query (SOQ) system client server application enables users to create and generate ad-hoc reports against multiple Oracle and Informix databases based on user-generated queries. The electronic files generated are used for tracking and managing soldier information. The SOQ uses a point and click Windows interface that generates Structured Query Language requests to a database. It provides label and electronic forms generation, and includes a grid map portion that enables users to locate soldiers by geographic area within the continental United States (CONUS).</p> <p>The application is a center wide tool that enables authorized users to generate ad-hoc, user defined reports, against a Soldier's data that resides in databases such as total Army personnel database- reserve (TAPDB-R), Shared, Active Guard Reserve Management Information System by running custom reports</p> <p>RN 600-8-104x Title Soldier Query (SOQ) System Master File Authority TBD PA TBD</p> <p>Description The TAPDB-R includes human resource management data on Army Reserve (individual ready reserve, individual mobilization augmentee, active guard reserve, troop program unit) soldiers, veterans and retirees. The master file database contains records created at point of accession or initial entry into military service. The primary key is social security number. Soldier data is collected by geographic location within CONUS. The system contains one record for each Army reserve soldier, veteran and retiree.</p> <p>Disposition PERMANENT TP Keep until no longer needed for conducting business, then retire to AEA. The code book identifies and interprets all codes used to record data and the records management portion of the Integrated Logistics Support Plan (ILSP). The AEA will transfer to the National Archives when the record is 25 years old.</p> <p>Proponent is G-1</p> <p>Justification The Soldier Query data must be retained indefinitely to track and manage the Army Soldiers histories. The baseline data are maintained in order to identify, document, audit and control the training, assignments and campaign histories. The baseline data are used to determine benefits, entitlements and to manage the careers of Army Soldiers far beyond the regulatory six year timeframe. (For example, an Army Soldier may need verification of a campaign assignment to Vietnam to qualify for medical benefits related to Agent orange)</p>		

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
