Included are user guides and manuals relating to the system architecture, indexing criteria (for retrieval), field definitions, records layout, data elements, and code books that identify and interpret all codes used to record data. Other functions include enhancing or upgrading aircraft functional usefulness through MWO, material change, and product improvement.</p> <p>Disposition PERMANENT TP Keep in the Army Electronic Archives (AEA) until no longer needed for conducting business. The AEA will transfer to the National Archives when the record is 20 years old.</p> <p>Justification The master file should be retained indefinitely to trace and revise the history of all weapon system data. Many components are shared among multiple systems and will not be removed.
