**SUMMARY**

The Department of the Army, Information Systems Command, requests disposition authority for Corps of Engineers Field Recovery Note Files (geodetic control stations) MARKS FN 115-11y (TAFFS 518-03), documents consisting of notes made in the field about control stations visited or used. These records are closely related to a number of other series of basic mapping program records which have been recommended for permanent retention: see N1-AU-86-28; 29; 30; 31; 36; 37; 45; and 49.

I recommend that we approve the schedule.

**RECOMMENDATION**
