1.	BACKGROUND: The proponent of AR 600-8-1, Casualty and Memorial Affairs and Line of Duty Investigations, has combined file numbers 600-8-a -1a - Casualty cases and 600-8-1b - Casualty evidence. The merging of these files was necessary because both files describe information generated concerning individual soldiers for whom presumptive findings of death have been made and for those who are currently listed as prisoners of war or missing in action. Request "Expedite" due to volume of records and political implications involved. FN: 600-8-1b Title: Casualty cases and evidence Privacy Act: Not applicable. Description: Documents relating to individual casualties, missing persons boards, boards of inquest, and documents reflecting the		

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status or possible information concerning casualties. Documents are accumulated by casualty reporting activities and by the HQDA office which has staff responsibility for processing casualties. Included are copies of casualty reports and messages, notifications to next-of-kin, and related information.

Disposition:

a. Office having Armywide responsibility: Retain records in the current file area until final resolution is achieved. At that time, the file should be cut off and retired to the National Personnel Records Center with the next regular shipment and destroyed 75 years after cutoff.

b. Other offices: Destroy when no longer needed for reference.
