Information consists of deceased person's name; age; race; sex; nationality; occupation; residence; and date, place, and cause of death. Also includes information on disposition of remains, date and place of burial (if interred in Corozal Cemetery); including interment number; marker number; section, row, and grave number; date of cremation; or date shipped to the United States and name of vessel.
