In this disposition request, Army is seeking authority to reduce the retention period for its Individual Financial History Files, FN 319-03, from 10 years to 6 years, 3 months. This reduction is in keeping with the change in the statute of limitations period accomplished by PL 93-604, and was agreed to by GAO after extensive discussions with the Army. If approved, the reduction will effect the retention of some 106,000 cu. ft. of these files currently stored at the Dayton FRC; however no immediate impact will be felt since these files are under a freeze ("BZZ") relating to the Wyatt et al. v. Nixon et al. litigation. GAO and Army having agreed to the proposed reduction in retention period, I recommend approval of this disposition request. NNM concurrence is not required.
