> Individual Case Investigation (History) Files: rogatory personnel security investigations relating to individual Department of the Navy personnel, applicants for positions, and some non-DOD personnel, accumulated placer to 1948 by the Naval Intelligence Command and the Naval Investigative Service (formerly the Office of Naval Intelligence of the Office of the Chief of Naval Operations). The records presently are stored at the Washington National Records Center under accession number 9000, as a part of Record, Group 28. They contain copies of National Agency Checks, transmittal letters, personal history statements, local agency checks, cross reference sheets to other documentation (which by now should have been destroyed), miscellaneous documents with insufficient data to identify the individual (such as for a John SMITH), copies of other agency background investigations, World War II newspaper clippings, requests for change of Navy designa-
