Records Relating to Contractors,
Pacific Naval Air Bases, 1941-55.

Contractors, Pacific Naval Air Bases, was a consortium of eight construction firms contracted by the U.S. Navy in 1940 to fortify the Pacific islands and to build such facilities as barracks and offices. When the Japanese conquered these islands during the war, they captured many CPNAB employees and held them as prisoners until the end of the war. The question of benefits due these employees was not settled until 1952.

One-time disposal authority is requested for the three record series hereinafter described on this SF 115.
