Background Information	<p><b>BACKGROUND</b> The Defense Sexual Assault Incident Database (DSAID) is a centralized, case-level database for the collection of record data regarding incidents of sexual assaults involving a member of the Armed Forces. DSAID contains information on Unrestricted and Restricted Reports (de-identified data) of sexual assault. Information includes, if available, Nature of the assault, victim and alleged perpetrator data, and case outcomes in connection with the assault. The system includes the capability for entering records and interfacing data, generating various level reports and queries, and conducting case and business management. See System of Records Notice DHRA 06, DSAID (November 21, 2012, 77 FR 69442). Sexual Assault Response Coordinators input data into DSAID manually (e.g., transfer of information collected through conversation with the victim) and via scanned image file upload (DD Form 2910, "Victim Reporting Preference Statement"). Case information maintained in the system is received, when appropriate, from Military Service-specific systems that capture sexual assault data, to include Military Criminal Investigative Organizations and Military Service sexual assault case management systems. This system replaces Defense Case Records Management System (DCRMS), scheduled under N1-330-08-07, Item 1.</p> <p><b>System Inputs</b> Forms used to collect and input information into DSAID (e.g., DD Form 2910, "Victim Reporting Preference Statement" and DD Form 2911, "DoD Sexual Assault Forensic Examination Report") are scheduled under GRS 20, Item 2(a)4. Information received from Military Service-specific systems are scheduled under GRS 20, Item 2c.</p>

**System Outputs** Ad hoc reports and queries generated by the system are scheduled under GRS 20, Item 16 The DoD Annual Report on Sexual Assault in the Military is scheduled under N1-330-08-07, Item 2

System contains information on the victim, alleged perpetrator, incident, and case outcomes in connection with the assault. Unrestricted Report records contain victim and alleged perpetrator information, including, but not limited to, the following: Last name, first name, middle name, identification type (i.e., social security number, passport, U.S. Permanent Residence Card, foreign identification), identification number for type of identification type referenced, birth date, age at the time of incident, gender, race, ethnicity, and victim and alleged perpetrator type (i.e., military, DoD civilian/contractor). For victims only, information will also include the victim case number (a system generated unique control number).
