**Background Information** 

The Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) is a headquarters-level staff of the Department of Defense of the United States of America. It is the principal civilian staff element of the Secretary of Defense, and it assists the Secretary in carrying out authority, direction and control of the Department of Defense in the exercise of policy development, planning, resource management, fiscal, and program evaluation responsibilities.

Under Secretary of Defense for Policy (USD/P&R): The Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness (OUSD(P&R)) is the principal staff element for the Department of Defense for all human resources, human capital development, and personnel logistics matters. The USD(P&R) is also responsible for training, health affairs, National Guard and Reserve affairs, personnel requirements for weapons support, and military and civilian family matters, subject to the authority of the Secretary of Defense.

Assistant Secretary of Defense for Health Affairs (ASD(HA)): ASD(HA) is the principal advisor to the U.S. Secretary of Defense on all "DoD health policies, programs and activities." In addition to exercising oversight of all DoD health resources, ASD(HA) serves as director of the Defense Health Activity. Overseas the Military Health System (MHS) is one of America's largest and most complex health care institutions, and is responsible for providing health services through both Direct Care Direct care refers to military hospitals and clinics, also known as "military treatment facilities" (MTF), direct care and overseas Private Sector Care to approximately 9.6 million beneficiaries, composed of uniformed service members, military retirees, and family members.

Defense Health Activity (DHA)

DHA is a joint, integrated Combat Support Agency that enables the Army, Navy, and Air Force medical services to provide a medically ready force and ready medical force to Combatant Commands in both peacetime and wartime. The DHA supports the delivery of integrated, affordable, and high quality health services to Military Health System (MHS) beneficiaries and is responsible for driving greater integration of clinical and business processes across the MHS.

Armed Forces Medical Examiner System (AFMES)
AFMES provides the DoD and other federal agencies comprehensive forensic investigative services, to include forensic pathology, DNA Forensics, forensic toxicology, and medical mortality surveillance.
AFMES is not only the single worldwide medical examiner system, but it also supports the Non-DoD agencies including but not limited to: Department of Justice
