The National Advisory Council on Educational Research and Improvement (NACERI) was established in 1972 as the National Council on Educational Research (NCER). NACERI advises the Office of Educational Research and Improvement, located within the United States Department of Education.

The National Advisory Council on Educational Research and Improvement is a temporary advisory council, which will end operations in September 1994.

Item 1. Minutes

a. Audio recordings (cassettes) of meetings - audio cassette tape recordings of NACERI meetings, held quarterly and then semiannually, from 1985 - 1991.

Disposition: Temporary. Destroy upon termination of Advisory Council.

b. Records of meetings - Paper copy of transcripts, minutes, agendas, resolutions, and documentation provided to Council members, 1981 - 1994.

Disposition: Permanent. Transfer to the Washington National Records Center upon termination of Advisory Council. Transfer to the National Archives in February 1995.

Disposition: Permanent. Transfer to the Washington National Records Center upon termination of Advisory Council. Transfer to the National Archives in February 1995.

Item 4. Organization and Function Files - bylaws, nomination records, press releases about Council members' nominations, lists of Council members and terms served, and budget statements. The records in this series date from 1985 to 1994.

Disposition: Permanent. Transfer to the Washington National Records Center upon termination of Advisory Council. Transfer to the National Archives in February 1995.

Acc. on hand: one cubic foot.

Item 5. Routine Administrative Files - inhouse communications pertaining to personnel changes, negotiation of meeting dates and places, and other housekeeping matters.

Disposition: Temporary. Destroy upon termination of Advisory Council.
