Borehole Drilling and Tunnel/Shaft Mining Project (BDTMP) Files. The records consist of, but are not limited to, the following subjects:

<u>Borehole Surveys</u>, including the following drill holes: emplacement, exploratory, cable, back assembly, instrument, probe, canister access, post shot, shaft, core, piledriver, and slifer. Also included are geophone and pre-mine throw surveys.

<u>Site Logs</u>, including textual and mylar logs for temperature, water location, caliper spectralogs, acoustilog, induction, gamma ray, density, salinometer, fluid density, and others.

Hoist Records, including mining hoists, cooling system hoists, shaft and hoist inspection reports, mining power, equipment, requirements, mining engineering and drafting requirements, mining procurement, mining methods, underground chambers, and hole complex histories.

<u>Technical and Scientific Records</u>, including emplacement hole, fire and safety inspectors' tour, drilling program revisions, drilling requirements, pay and cost estimates, cementing and polymer data.

Additional records may include general and program correspondence; progress reports and photographs; Atomic Energy Commission congressional reports (including contractor-supplied data); inspector reports; Department of Energy and contractor annual reports, contractor correspondence files; drawings, blueprints, and technical specifications for BDTMP-related equipment, significant contracting and budgetary records.

The records may exist in both paper and microfilm. If microfilm, it will have been prepared in accordance with the standards set forth in 36 Code of Federal Regulations 1230.

## **DISPOSITION:**

a. Textual records when not microfilmed:

Retain on site. Destroy when 75 years old or when no longer needed for reference, whichever is later.\*

b. Textual records converted to microfilm.

Destroy upon verification of the microfilm.

c. Microfilm - silver halide and diazo copies.

Retain on site. Destroy when 75 years old or when no longer needed for reference, whichever is later.
