Background Information

Attracting and retaining top-level talent in a variety of different scientific, clinical, technical, and administrative areas is in the best interest of the National Institutes of Health (NIH). To support this principle, the NIH Director, the directors of the national research institutes, including the National Cancer Institute (NCI), the National Library of Medicine (NLM), and the National Center for Complementary and Integrative Health (NCCIH) have the authority to engage in research training fellowships with Postdoctoral, Pre-Doctoral, Post-Baccalaureate, Technical, and Student Candidates, and Scientists. For the relevant authorities, see 42 U.S.C. 282(b)(11) (authority for the NIH Director); 42 U.S.C. 284(b)(1)(D (authority for the directors of the national research institutes); 42 U.S.C. 285a-2(b) (3) (authority for the Director of NCI; 42 U.S.C. 286b-3 (authority for the Director of NLM); 42 U.S.C. 287c-21(a) (authority for the Director of NCCIH); and, 42 C.F.R. Part 63 (regulations applying to research traineeships).

This schedule covers administrative records created in support of non-Full Time Employment (FTE) appointments executed through NIH fellowships that include: the Intramural Research Training Award (IRTA), Cancer Research Training Award (CRTA), Visiting Fellow (VF), and other fellowship programs authorized under the citations noted above.

Intramural Research Training Award (IRTA) Program
The Intramural Research Training Award (IRTA) Fellowship Program
is designed to provide advanced training and practical research
experiences to investigators early in their professional research
careers. IRTA Traineeships are established for the principal benefit of

the participant and to provide opportunities for developmental training and practical research experience in a variety of disciplines related to biomedical research, medical library research, and related fields.

Cancer Research Training Award (CRTA) Program
The Cancer Research Training Award (CRTA) Program is an NCIspecific fellowship award program that establishes an "umbrella"
appointment mechanism with uniform provisions and a streamlined
application process for the diverse training fellowship programs
supported throughout NCI's Divisions and Offices. CRTA Fellows are
accepted for training in scientific disciplines that will enhance public
health efforts to prevent, diagnose, or treat cancer, a disease of major
public health significance.

Visiting Fellow Program

The Visiting Fellow (VF) program allows scientists from around the world the opportunity to work with senior NIH investigators on research areas of mutual interest. The program is designed to provide non-immigrant foreign participants opportunities for developmental training and practical research experience in a variety of disciplines related to biomedical research, medical library research, and related fields.
