## Files of the Financing of Graduate Medical Education Study, 1980-1985

The study of the Financing of Graduate Medical Education was sponsored by the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Planning and Evaluation in the Department of Health and Human Services and conducted primarily by the Arthur Young Company. It was designed to address policy issues in the area of graduate medical education. The study was based on an understanding that important social benefits are derived from the operation of teaching hospitals that train residents and interns in health care. But historically, the cost of running these facilities has been higher than non-teaching hospitals. The purpose of this study was to compare the operation of 45 hospitals -- 36 teaching and 9 non-teaching -- in order to determine why the costs of running teaching hospitals appear to be so much higher.

Item 1. Financing of Graduate Education Data Collection Forms, 1983-1985: Forms used to collect data about hospital revenues and costs; the routine activities of residents, other physicians, and nurses; the information contained in each hospitals discharge abstract tape and sampled medical records; and general data describing each hospital and its economic environment. Total cubic footage: Approximately 200 cubic feet. Office of Record: Office of Planning and Evaluation, Department of Health and Human Services.
