Item 1 AHRQ Healthcare Cost and Utilization Project

The Heathcare Cost and Utilization Project provides a collection of health care databases developed through a Federal-State-Industry partnership and sponsored by the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality HCUP is based on statewide data collected by individual data organizations across the United States and provided to AHRQ through HCUP partnership data use agreements

HCUP databases include but are not limited to the following

- The Nationwide Inpatient Sample (NIS)—inpatient data from a national sample of over 1,000 hospitals
- The Kids' Inpatient Database (KID)—a nationwide sample of pediatric inpatient discharges
- The State Inpatient Databases (SID)—contain inpatient discharge abstracts from participating states
- The State Ambulatory Surgery Databases (SASD)—contain data from ambulatory care encounters from hospital-affiliated and sometimes freestanding ambulatory surgery sites
- The State Emergency Department Databases (SEDD)—contain data from hospital-affiliated emergency departments for visits that do not result in hospitalizations
- a Inputs Participating organizations provide AHRQ with raw data from discharge abstracts, and AHRQ converts the information into a standard format
 - <u>Disposition</u>-TEMPORARY Delete after information has been transferred to the master file and verified GRS 20, item 1b
- b Master file Contains clinical and nonclinical information collected from state and private industry partners from discharge abstracts including diagnoses and procedures, discharge status, patient demographics, and charges

AHRQ uses HCUPnet to provide the public with access to data from the HCUP databases Information available in HCUPnet is made available by participating partners, HCUPnet hosts non-sensitive aggregate statistics from the HCUP data HCUPnet currently features data from NIS, KID, NEDS, and SID databases
