Item 1. AHRQ Electronic Preventive Services Selector (ePSS)

AHRQ Electronic Preventive Services Selector (ePSS) is a quick, hands-on tool designed to help primary care clinicians identify and offer the screening, counseling, and preventive medication services that are appropriate for their patients. The ePSS is based on the current, evidence-based recommendations of the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF)

a) Input: The U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) is an independent, non-governmental panel of experts that provides scientific evidence, recommendations on clinical preventive services, and information on how to implement recommended preventive services in clinical practices to AHRQ on a semi-annual basis. These recommendations are reviewed by AHRQ staff for quality and completeness and subsequently loaded into a relational database which supports both the ePSS website and ePSS mobile applications.
