The HDW is used internally by HRSA employees and managers, and externally by state and local governments, academia, and current and prospective HRSA grantees, the U.S. Congress, and the public. The HDW integrates HRSA program data with external data sources, such as the U.S. Census Bureau, enabling users to view relevant and meaningful information about health care programs and the populations they serve. The HDW helps tell the story of HRSA’s positive impact on public health and helps HRSA meet open government and transparency initiatives.

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Item Description	HRSA's Enterprise Data Science and Analytic platform (HEDSAP), forms a single data platform to govern HRSA's data sets and enable secure data sharing. This platform will enable the authoritative data engineering platform for scalable data preparation, model inference pipeline and integrate data science and statistical analysis tools for predictive analytics. Enablement of data driven decision making, data traceability, security, audit and sharing of the curated data sets with external partners. Using the HEDSAP platform, bureaus and offices can implement innovative solutions to maximize the power of data in analytics, statistical and reporting domains, which will align with HHS Data Strategy and Cross-Agency Priority (CAP) Goal to "Leverage data as a strategic asset." This also aligns with Federal Open Data initiatives to make HRSA's program data more transparent and accessible to the public and to partner systems.
