Department of Homeland Security

The Federal Advisory Committee Act (or FACA) is a United States federal law (Pub.L. 92-463, 6 October 1972), which governs the behavior of advisory committees. In particular it restricts the formation of such committees to only those which are deemed essential, limits their powers to provision of advice to officers and agencies in the executive branch of the Federal Government, and limits the length of term during which any such committee may operate

Federal advisory committee members are drawn from nearly every occupational and industry group and geographical section of the United States and its territories. The FACA requires that committee memberships be "fairly balanced in terms of the points of view represented and the functions to be performed " As a result, members of specific committees often have both expertise and professional skills that parallel the program responsibilities of their sponsoring agencies. In balancing committee memberships, agencies are expected to assure that major, and sometimes strongly opposing, viewpoints are represented to provide a foundation for developing advice and recommendations that are fair and comprehensive

Presidential committees, boards, and councils are covered by the Presidential Records Act. The Presidential Records Act of 1978 mandated that the records of former presidents would automatically become the property of the federal government upon his leaving the Oval Office, and then transferred to the Archivist of the United States, thereafter to be made available to the public after no more than twelve years

Presidential Advisory Committees are established by Presidential authority.

Agency officials, Members of Congress, the general public, or professional societies or current and former committee members may nominate potential candidates for membership. Selection of committee members is made based on the FACA's requirements and the potential member's background and qualifications.

Unless otherwise noted, all disposition instructions are media neutral; they apply regardless of the media or format of the records.
