This schedule covers temporary accounts for external users such as attorneys, accredited representatives, and most non-immigrants. The following related records are governed by other retention authorities as noted. Management reports including, but not limited to workload, accounts, case cycle time, case status, risk and fraud, content management, etc. are covered by NARA General Records Schedules (GRS) 20, Item 16; such reports will be deleted/destroyed when no longer needed for agency business. Internal user accounts for federal and contract employees are covered by GRS 24, Item 6; such accounts will be deleted/destroyed 6 years after the account is terminated or when no longer needed for investigative or security purposes, whichever is later.
