Firearms, Armor, and Credential Tracking System (FACTS)

The Firearms, Armor, and Credential Tracking System (FACTS) is the successor of a legacy system referred to as Firearms Operating Module (FOM) which had a NARA Job Number of N1-85-98-01 and was a subsystem of the Asset Management Information System (AMIS). AMIS is no longer operational. The system was designed to implement controls and strengthen procedures to promote effectiveness and efficiency in asset management and safeguard Government owned property, specifically firearms, body armor, badges, credentials and other law enforcement equipment. FACTS was designed to support the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) National Firearms and Technical Training Unit's (NFTTU) mission, specifically the tracking of sensitive property.

FACTS records balances, acquisitions, withdrawals and calculates ending balances expressed in values and physical units for all property—It also also maintains purchase order information, requisition, and delivery dates

FACTS generates inventory reports, as well as ad hoc query reports

Firearms, Armor, and Credential Tracking System (FACTS)

A. Master File/Data

(1) Dispositioned Firearms

Information related to instances of agency firearms that have been dispositioned. Dispositioning can take place through destruction, return to vendor and replaced, excessed through General Services Administration (GSA), donation through state and local surplus with GSA or transfer to another Federal agency

(2) Lost Firearms

Information related to instances of agency firearms that have been lost. This material includes, but is not limited to

- Initial Memoranda from Officer reporting the loss
- · Officer's narrative of the situation surrounding the loss
