

**Online Detainee Locator System (ODLS)**

---

The Online Detainee Locator System (ODLS) is a publicly accessible, web-based system owned by U S Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) ODLS allows the public to conduct online Internet-based queries to locate persons arrested and detained by ICE for administrative violations of the Immigration and Nationality Act ODLS is intended to allow members of the public, especially family members and legal representatives, to determine whether an individual is currently in ICE detention and, if so, at which facility the person is detained

**1. Online Detainee Locator System (ODLS)**

**A Master File/Data**

**( 1 ) Detainee Information**

ODLS contains information on current ICE detainees and detainees who have been booked out of ICE custody (regardless of the reason) within the previous sixty (60) days Specifically, ODLS contains

- Full Name
- Alien Number
- Date of Birth
- Country of Birth
- Custody Status ("in custody" / "not in custody")
- Detention facility where the person is being held (name, location, contact information)
- ERO office responsible for the detainee's immigration case

**Disposition:**

TEMPORARY Cutoff upon detainee release from ICE custody Destroy/delete sixty (60) days after cutoff
