Additional Schedule Information	This schedule covers incident-driven and fixed facility surveillance audio/video recordings created by United States Customs and Border Protection law enforcement personnel using cameras to include, but not limited to fixed facility surveillance and monitoring cameras, body-worn, mobile, and vessel-mounted cameras during the course of their official duties, and training footage. Incident-driven recordings are the result of law enforcement-related events that require on-duty law enforcement personnel to activate a camera such as a body-worn, mobile, and vessel-mounted camera recording device. Fixed facility surveillance audio/video recordings are gathered from cameras that are installed at ports of entry, ports of operation, and select Office of Border Patrol locations. Incident-driven and fixed facility surveillance recordings result in the creation of audio/video files. The recorded data will result in three types of audio/video files: 1) audio/video files that have no evidentiary value; 2) audio/video files that have been tagged as being of potential law enforcement significance; and 3) audio/video files that have evidentiary value. For use in this schedule, the following definitions apply: Non-Evidentiary- Audio/Video recorded by law enforcement personnel during the normal course of the performance of their duties determined to have no evidentiary value. Captured Events (potentially evidentiary)- Any recorded data that captures an action of law enforcement significance that has not been pulled into any criminal, administrative, civil, or other legal proceeding. Evidentiary- Any recorded data that may have material or probative value, or may have bearing on any criminal, administrative, civil, or other legal proceeding. Audio/Video Files determined to have evidentiary value shall be preserved under established rules of evidence with the associated case file.
