Documentation on cases varies commensurate with governing agreements. In substance, the inclusive records consist of wage data, signed interview sheets and statements, affidavits, news clippings, exhibits, credit reports, income tax information, investigator's reports, (HUD, Justice and other), disposition reports, administrative forms controlling each case, and related correspondence.
