Disposition May be deleted from the email system after copying to a recordkeeping system

3 <u>Word Processing Files</u> Documents such as letters, memoranda, reports, handbooks, directives, and materials recorded on electronic media, such as hard disks or floppy disketts that meet the definition of a federal record, after they have been copied to an electronic system, paper, or microfilm for recordkeeping purposes

<u>Disposition</u> May be deleted from the word processing system when no longer needed for updating or revision
