Developed in 2007/2008, the Appraisal Management System provides an accurate historical and current log of the workload of the Land Acquisition Unit and is an effective tracking and planning tool. It provides information on appraisers, their rating, specialty, location, and assignments. The system also provides detailed information on an appraisal.

1. Inputs

Select information is imported nightly from ENRD Case Management System. All other data is manually entered by a Land Acquisition Unit staff member.

Disposition: TEMPORARY. Destroy/Delete when entered and verified in Master File. (GRS 20)

2. Master File

Data in this system contains privileged attorney work product, specifically dealing with expert witness testimony and litigation. Some of the major fields include Case Name, DOJ Number, Tract Name, Appraiser Name, Reviewer Name, Project, and Review Date, Recommendation, Appraised Values and Notes.

3. Outputs

The system provides several static reports such as: Assigned Reviews, Appraisal Activity, Appraiser History, Completed Reviews, Case History, etc.
