1 Inputs

New case information is entered into the Automated Case Management System (ACMS) by electronic download from the bankruptcy courts. The relevant case data is subsequently uploaded into DAS. In addition, the USTP field staff record the audit results in DAS. EOUST staff will record the payment status.

Disposition TEMPORARY, delete/destroy after data has been successfully captured, entered, and verified in DAS and is no longer needed

2 Master File

DAS stores relevant case information including case number, debtor name, debtor attorney, judge assigned, judicial district, audit type, contractor name (including mailing address and contact information), contractor DUNS and taxpayer ID number, purchase order number, invoice number and status, and audit status and results

Disposition TEMPORARY, cut off when case is closed Destroy/delete 20 years after cutoff

3 Outputs

DAS has various status reports for staff to track audit assignments, status of audits and status of invoices
