U.S. Department of Justice Office of the Inspector General Evaluation and Inspections Division Resolution Tracking System

The Evaluation and Inspections Division (E&I) provides the Inspector General with an alternative mechanism to traditional audit and investigative disciplines to assess DOJ programs and activities. In addition to assessing DOJ programs, the Division conducts special reviews requested by the Inspector General or senior DOJ management that arise suddenly and need immediate attention.

The Resolution Tracking System captures information about the progress of resolving OIG recommendations issued in a final E&I report.

1. Inputs.

<u>Description</u>: Authorized E&I personnel input the data manually as events occur. Data may come from a variety of sources, including but not limited to final reports, internal correspondence within E&I, oral discussions, and external correspondence between E&I and a component.

Disposition: TEMPORARY. File source documents, where available, with the appropriate evaluation or inspection work file.

2. Master File.

<u>Description</u>: A simple, single-user application designed by end user to track incoming and outgoing resolution correspondence dates for open recommendations from final E&I reports. Includes, but is not limited to, Inspection Name, Inspection Number, Component, Due Date, Date Called, Extension Requested, Approved By, Received, Extension Overdue, and Comments.

<u>Disposition</u>: TEMPORARY. Cut off at the end of the fiscal year in which all recommendations resulting from an evaluation or inspection are closed. Delete/destroy 15 years after cutoff or when the agency determines that they are no longer needed for administrative, legal, audit, or other operational purposes, whichever is later.

3. Output.

<u>Description</u>: The system generates ad hoc reports as needed.

Disposition: TEMPORARY. Destroy/delete when no longer needed. LRS 70, item 16
