Implemented in 2003, the TSOU Log system is an Oracle database that is a repository to document the management and disposition of all terrorist watchlist encounters reported to TSOU by the Terrorist Screening Center (TSC). TSOU operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and communicates with FBI Field Offices, legal attaches (Legats), and other government agencies in managing encounters with watch listed individuals. TSOU logs the information received, notifications made, the actions taken and encounter disposition into the TSOU Log system. Based on the information received from TSC, TSOU conducts preliminary analysis,		
	makes immediate notifications or assignments for action on encounters, and provides timely dispositions to FBI Field Offices, legats, and other government agencies. Information in the system is up to the classification level of Secret.		
	A. INPUTS TSOU staff members key in data, which is typically derived from TSC encounter call sheets, EMA printouts, telephone calls, and source documents that contain information regarding previous encounters, prior intelligence gathered, and/or investigations of individuals on the terrorist watchlist.		
•	1. Source Records The primary sources of records are TSC encounter call sheets (2003-late 2007) and Encounter Management Application (EMA) printouts (began in late 2007).
