	The Data Extraction and Extension Project (DEEP) was a web-based Oracle application, which was developed by the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Counterterrorism Division (FBI, CTD) DEEP was envisioned as a storage repository for information about the subjects of FBI counterterrorism investigations Initially, DEEP was populated with data from the Universal Index (UNI) and the Investigative Case Management (ICM) components of the Automated Case Support (ACS) system Regular updates from UNI and ICM kept the DEEP data synchronized with ACS Users were able to enhance the DEEP records with information that was already in the case file, but not easily retrievable because of its unstructured or non-electronic format		
	Since its May 2005 release, DEEP has not fulfilled its potential CTD conducted an extensive review of the system and determined that manually typing information into DEEP added administrative burden with no discernable value to investigators CTD opined that other FBI applications were being utilized with greater frequency and success and that the continued maintenance of DEEP was not warranted Therefore, the DEEP application has been retired
