The VCC provides case management and related information processing capabilities which can be accessed by other federal, state, local, or tribal law enforcement agencies during planned special events and unplanned large-scale incidents. In some instances, the FBI may not be a participant in the event or investigation, but rather, may only be involved in providing support services related to the activation of the Virtual Command Center.

Data resides on the VCC temporarily during the management of the special event. Records associated with an FBI investigation are captured within FBI case files as close to real time as possible. For those events in which the FBI is only providing system support, an electronic copy of the data is provided to the responsible law enforcement agencies to further their investigative activities. Upon conclusion of the critical incident or special event, the VCC is purged of data and reimaged in preparation for the next activation.

1. Inputs: Investigative leads and other information are provided by federal, state, tribal, and local authorities

DISPOSITION Temporary DELETE/DESTROY upon verification of successful input into the database

2. Outputs:

(a) Records which lead to an FBI investigation

DISPOSITION Provide an electronic copy of the master file to the FBI office responsible for the investigation of the incident or management of the special event to be incorporated into the appropriate case file

(b) Records which lead to a non-FBI investigation

DISPOSITION Provide an electronic copy of the master file to the law enforcement agency responsible for the investigation of the incident or management of the special event

3. Master file. The master file contains leads, tips, and other information gathered during a crisis or special event

DISPOSITION Temporary DELETE/DESTROY after cessation of the command post activities, following verification of successful data migration or replication for provision to the appropriate law enforcement agency as stated in item 2

4. System Documentation: Data system specifications, file specifications, codebooks, record layouts, user guides, output specifications, and final reports (regardless of medium)

DISPOSITION Temporary DELETE/DESTROY when superseded or obsolete, or upon decommission of the Virtual Command Center
