1.	<p style="text-align: center;">AGREEMENTS BETWEEN TRANSPORTATION LINES AND THE UNITED STATES</p> <p>This schedule covers the contractual agreements, including accompanying documentation, with transportation lines, referred to in section 238 of the Immigration and Nationality Act. Contractual agreements concern transportation lines engaged in carrying alien passengers to the United States from foreign contiguous territory or from adjacent islands shall provide and maintain at its expense suitable landing stations, approved by the Attorney General, conveniently located at the point or points of entry; and enter into contracts including bonding agreements to guarantee the passage through the United States in immediate and continuous transit of aliens destined to foreign countries.</p> <p>Duplicate records are maintained by the Office of Inspections at Headquarters, and the Regional and District Office of jurisdiction, and a copy of the agreement is provided to the transportation line.
