1. FORM I-92 - Aircraft/Vessel Report

Form I-92 is used to record the total number of passengers (including United States citizens) that embark at each port enroute to the United States. Form I-92 is presented by the master to the immigrant inspector at the first port of arrival in the United States. This information is furnished to the Service by each aircraft or vessel granted permission to use I-94 procedure upon arrival and departure.

Destroy I-92's dated thru September 1983, after all statistical data has been extracted and verified on related-magnetic tapes. Magnetic tapes are maintained in DOT, Transportation Systems Center.
