The National Institute of Correction

The National Institute of Corrections (NIC) is an agency within the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Prisons. The Institute is headed by a Director appointed by the Attorney General of the United States. Both a direct-service and funding agency, NIC's five legislatively mandated activities are training, technical assistance, research and evaluation, policy and standard's formulation and implementation.

NIC's Information Center and Library were established in response to the legislative mandate "to serve as a clearinghouse and information center for the collection, preparation, and dissemination of information on corrections" NIC acquires and disseminates practical, useful, operationally oriented materials and documents dealing with the most current issues and innovations in the field of corrections. A function of the Information Center is the maintenance and operation of the Robert J. Kutak Memorial Library - the entity that houses all of NIC's publications. The NIC web site helps transmit and serves as central point of access for the public as well as local, state, and other external jurisdictions served by NIC.

1 NIC'S WEB SITE:

National Institute of Corrections' Internet (<u>www nicic gov</u>), was built in 1998 to introduce the services that NIC provides and for easier access to the NIC's library, its services and projects

A. INPUT: Documents originating from the NIC Library system among other database sources. Non-database input consists of PDF, DOC, and/or Flash digital video files use to provide information about NIC's training, services, projects, news, publications, reports, instructions, procedures, and news summaries among a variety of materials and information of public interest that meets the mission and scope of the agency.

Disposition: Temporary. Destroy when no longer needed for reference purposes.

B OUTPUT: Streaming digital video, audio, and/or presentation/training content

Documents, lessons, and course or project documents in PDF, HTML, or other digital format. Reports consisting of search results, inventory lists, or other site content catalogue-related research materials. Summary statistical reports concerning user trend analysis, system response time tracking, and system optimization analysis.

Disposition Temporary. Destroy when no longer needed for reference purposes

C DATA Copies of electronic text (HTML/PDF), images (JPEG), digital video/audio, and fielded database information describing products, services, and customer marketing materials for public dissemination. Also includes user information extracted from a connection to the website. Details may consist of users' internet domain name, IP address, browser and operating system, date and time of connection, areas accessed, information requested, possible errors encountered, and the website from which the connection took place, among other information elements primarily collected for system monitoring, statistical analysis and technical improvements to the site

Disposition Temporary Destroy when superceded, obsolete, or when no longer needed for reference purposes.

D. SYSTEM DOCUMENTATION Technical information (including record layout and code books) and instructional documentation demonstrating the use of the system, location of files, tables, and programming parameters, and other system functions.

Disposition. Temporary Destroy when superceded or no longer needed for system support and/or programming reference purposes
