The Office of Justice Programs (OJP) provides innovative leadership to Federal, state, local and tribal justice systems, by disseminating state-of-the-art knowledge and practices across America, and providing tools for the implementation of these crime fighting strategies

The first Regional Information Sharing Systems (RISS) Center was created in 1974 and the sixth and final Center came online in 1981. Potentially there can be files in the system from the start as long as purge rules were followed. The purpose of the system is to share state, local, and tribal law information to include intelligence information across a secure network operated and maintained through state/local oversight. This system receives federal funding, but is not classified as a federal system.

1 Inputs

- The data for the Regional Information Sharing Systems (RISS) is provided by state, local, and tribal criminal justice agencies who have agreed to share information across the RISS Network. The data is stored regionally at six locations and then accessed through a single user interface available on the RISS Network. All data is considered to be the property of the agency entering the information, and not RISS or any federal agency providing the operating funds.

- RISS does connect to other state and local databases that have agreed to share their information using the same user interface utilized by RISSIntel.

2 Master Plan

- The major databases within RISS are RISSIntel which is populated with intelligence information and RISSGang, both follow guidelines set by 28 CFR Part 23. The data field would include personal identifying information as well as agency contact information.

- RISS does connect to other state and local databases that have agreed to share their information using the same user interface utilized by RISSIntel.

Disposition PERMANENT Since records are the property of the state/local/tribal agency and they comply with 28 CFR Part 23 all records have to be verified every 5 years If not they are purged from the system.

3 Output

- There are no reports generated directly from RISS, but the user will get search results based on the fields placed in the query set
- Updates for the records are done by the individual agencies and each RISS Center conducts schedule backup of hosted data as part of their COOP Plan
