RCS 301, Item 41. Explosives Tracing System (XTS). This system enables other Federal, State, and local law enforcement agencies to initiate traces of recovered, stolen, or abandoned explosives, explosives materials, and criminally and illegally used explosives. A trace can assist investigators in determining the origin and identification of explosive materials and can provide investigative information for use in apprehending criminals. The system consists of the configuration and disposition of explosives products manufactured in the U.S., Canada, Mexico, and Austria.

a. Master File. Records date from 1973 to present.
