1. National Drug Threat Survey (NDTS) Master File

The National Drug Threat Survey (NDTS) collects primary data on the threat posed by various illicit drugs in the United States. A stratified random sample of state and local law enforcement agencies is surveyed to produce national, regional, and state estimates of various aspects of drug trafficking activities including the threat posed by various drugs, the availability and production of illicit drugs, as well as the role of street gangs and outlaw motorcycle gangs in drug trafficking activity. This is the database of information submitted from US law enforcement officials regarding the domestic drug threat.

For each survey the master files consist of two data files. One contains all the NDTS data fields and the other is a version where the fields containing personally identifiable information (PII) are redacted.
