The DMI system provides dynamic and static maps that contain information collected by NDIC in the course of producing domestic drug intelligence products. These maps show data on drug trends and threats and other drug-related information from across the United States through mapping applications.

**Master File**

Information is displayed in textual format and as a set of arrays on a geographic information system (GIS) map maintained on the NDIC Internet site from 2003 to present.
