UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE REQUIRED REPORTS (UIRR). 1. The UIRR is a component of the Unemployment Insurance Database (UIDB). The UIDB is an electronic system used for storage and retrieval of unemployment insurance information by Employment Training Administration, Department of Labor, authorized by the Social Security Act, Section 303 A6. unemployment insurance information is used to monitor States' performance, to be able to pay States based on workload, and to provide general statistics. The UIRR consists of data elements stored in tables made up of information obtained from required statistical reports submitted by State Employment Security Agencies (SESAs). Each table represents a set of related data and each of the tables contain some common information including report date and State. Some tables contain information that date back to 1971. Data includes all report tables, comment tables, and general tables necessary to understand data tables.

INCLUSIVE DATES: 1971 and thereafter.
ARRANGEMENT STATEMENT: Report date order.
STATEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS: There are no restrictions.

DISPOSITION: Permanent. Transfer copy of 1971 through 1991 data immediately to the National Archives. Thereafter, cutoff annually and transfer copy to the National Archives after 3 years.
