a. U.S. Space Objects Registry

Data manually entered into the database from faxes, letters and other documentation provided by Department of Defense (DOD), Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), and various other sources that include name of objects, name of launching state or states; appropriate designator or registration number; date and territory or location of launch; orbital parameters (nodal period, inclination, apogee, perigee); and general function and status of the space object for each items listed.

Disposition: Temporary. Destroy after the information has been converted to an electronic medium and verified, when no longer needed for legal or audit purposes or to support the reconstruction of, or serve as a backup to, the

electronic records, whichever is later.
