

7651. National Fire Plan Operations and Reporting System (NFPORS). Is an inter-departmental, inter-agency automated data management and reporting system funded jointly by DOI and USDA.

The system is used to manage the National Fire Plan, a mandated program that provides accountability for hazardous fuel reduction, burned area rehabilitation and community assistance activities. Reporting is in real time, used by managers and field employees throughout the country, providing crucial information for decision making and funding of the national wildfire program.

Disposition: Temporary. Cut off at the end of the fiscal year. Destroy 4 years after cut off.
