This request is submitted to change the retention period at the Records Center from 10 years to #8 years. The Bureau of Mines, Helium Operations, is involved in nine lawsuits at the present time with other suits pending, Included in the lawsuits are those concerning cancellation of the conservation contracts, property and land settlement, and helium sales. These suits involve approximately \$2,000,000,000. Records that are much older than the 10-year retention period for Helium Operations records at the Federal Records Center are being used in these proceedings.
