Treasury Enforcement Communications System (TECS) - San Diego system. On-line audit tapes, October, 1975-November, 1987.

Backup data created by TECS, including all data entered into the system plus audit trails for system use by each terminal and user. In addition to acting as a security backup, these tapes have been used for law enforcement purposes by the Office of Internal Affairs. The tapes were created during the period when TECS was based at the San Diego Data Center. When responsibility was moved to the Newington Data Center, the file was cut off and a new series (not covered by this job) was begun.

Total accumulation: 3300 reels of computer tape (229 cartons).

DISPOSITION: Transfer to FRC upon approval of schedule.

a) October, 1975-January, 1981 (78 cartons):

Destroy January, 2006.

b) February, 1981-December, 1983 (87 cartons):

Destroy January, 2009.

c) January, 1984-November, 1987 (64 cartons):
