	<p><u>CURRENCY AND FOREIGN TRANSACTIONS REPORTING ACT RECORDS</u></p> <p>These are records that pertain to criminal investigations of violations of the Currency and Foreign Transactions Reporting Act (P.L. 91-508). They consist of reports submitted by members of the public to U.S. Customs documenting the exporting of currency and monetary instruments and the maintenance of foreign bank and financial accounts. The reports are received, processed, and held for six years (the statute of limitations provided for in 18 U.S.C. 3282), during which time they could become evidentiary material supporting a criminal investigation. Once the statute of limitation expires, the records can be destroyed.</p> <p>Transfer to FARC as volume warrants on completion of processing.
