The files are from the years 1863 through 1945 and contain information regarding claims for Government securities. Some of these claims contain information about securities lost in bank robberies during the Great Depression, government securities lost in the Chicago fire of 1871, train robberies, steamship explosions and sinkings, and the 1923 fire that destroyed practically all of Berkeley, California, including a part of the University of California—Berkely campus, and other claims from unique times in American history. The files also contain exhibitable examples of government wax seals, including seals from countries that now no longer exist such as the Royal Kingdom of Bavaria. Most of the files contain routine claim files from the general public that would contain unique genealogical information that may be of use to family researchers.
